## NOTICE OF RACE

### Port Royal Classic Regatta Saturday, May 16, 2026

**RULES:** This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the event Sailing Instructions shall apply.

**ENTRIES:** Spinnaker and mariner vessels should hold a current PHRF rating. Boats that do not hold a PHRF rating will be assigned one by the Race Committee. For the "Plastic Classic" spinnaker and mariner classes, eligible vessels must be designed in 2001 or before, be constructed of fiberglass and have an overall length greater than 19 feet. The entry fee is \$35 for entries received with all fees paid by the discounted entry fee deadline of end of day Wednesday, May 6. Thereafter, until the entry deadline, the entry fee is \$40. Entrants shall complete the online entry process using the regatta management system website [https://www.regattaman.com/new\\_event\\_page.php?race\\_id=1104&yr=2026](https://www.regattaman.com/new_event_page.php?race_id=1104&yr=2026)

**VENUE:** The race area will be per the current KHYC Race Mark Guide, the Sailing Instructions and the Course Chart will be available online prior to Race Day.

**DIVISIONS:** There will be four classes: (A) Spinnaker, (B) Mariner/Non-Spinnaker, (C) Plastic Classic Spinnaker, (D) Plastic Classic Mariner/Non-Spinnaker. A Class must have a minimum of three (3) paid entries by the entry deadline to establish a Class.

A & C	PHRF standard and "classic"	"D" Flag 
B & D	Mariner/Non-Spin standard and "classic"	"E" Flag 

**SCHEDULE OF RACES:** Courses will be chosen from the PRYC Race Course Chart. All Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker boats will sail one race. Classic classes will be scored separately at the end.

**STARTS:** The start line will be between S-Mark and a flag on the port side of the Race Committee boat anchored to North of S-Mark. The first warning will be at 1255. Both the A&C classes will start at 1300. Both the B&D classes will start at 1305.

**FINISH:** The finish line for all classes will be just inside the harbor entrance between an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and the Redondo Beach East Jetty Light (#2) at the harbor entrance.

**PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 is changed so that the one or two turn penalty is replaced by a one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

**SCORING:** The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Area B2 RLC Course ratings will apply with TOD scoring for this race.

**TROPHIES:** Individual trophies for all four Classes will be awarded at PRYC following the race.

**HOSPITALITY:** All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. To keep the bar queue moving, drink tickets will be sold; cash is appreciated. All guests must sign-in at the door and require a name badge.

**AMENDMENT:** Rules are changed to include: Mechanical or electrical self-steering devices may be employed (after the start) by boats with only 2 or 1 crew. This modifies RRS Rule 52.
